Presentation by: Jason Brandt, Ph.D.

Dr. Brandt will be discussing normal age-related memory and other cognitive changes, Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI), Dementia, and Alzheimer's disease.

Dr. Brandt obtained his Ph.D. in experimental and physiological psychology from Boston University in 1982. Since that time, he has been on the faculty of Johns Hopkins University, where he is currently Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences, Professor of Neurology, and Director of the Division of Medical Psychology in the School of Medicine. He is also the Director of the Cortical Function Laboratory at the Johns Hopkins Hospital, and is a Research Director at the Copper Ridge Institute. Dr. Brandt's research focuses on memory and other cognitive disorders as they appear in Alzheimer's disease, Huntington's disease, and other degenerative brain disorders.
